# History - Why did the fire start and how did London change as a result?

**When and where did the Great Fire of London start?** The GFOL started on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 1666 in Pudding Lane Bakery.

## Who was Samuel Pepys?

Samuel Pepys is known for keeping a diary during the GFOL written in code.

### Vocab

Cathedral – a large church found in cities.

**Diary**—a personal written record of events by someone who was alive at the time.

Century—A period of 100 years.

## Personal Social Health Economic Education – What is a safe relationship?

What is a safe / unsafe secret? A safe secret is a secret to be kept for a short time eg: a birthday present or a surprise party – things that will make someone happy.

An unsafe secret is a secret you're expected to keep for a long time which might hurt someone or about something that has happened to you.

#### Vocab

**Similarities** – things that are the same or nearly the same as one another eg: similar hair colour.

**Differences** – something that is not the same as one another.

**Respect** – regard for the feelings, wishes or rights of others.

## Science – Why are some materials suitable for one job but not another?

Name 5 different types of materials.

Wood, glass, plastic, card, fabric, metal, rock.

What does manmade mean?

Manmade means that a material has been produced by humans and can't be found naturally.

### Vocab

**Properties**—This is what a material is like and how it behaves (soft, stretchy, waterproof).

**Material** — Materials are what objects are made from.

**Suitability**—having the properties which are right for a specific purpose. E.g. windows are made from glass because they are transparent.

## Religious Education – Why is Christmas important to Christians?

When is Advent? Advent is the 4 Sundays before Christmas.

**What does Christmas celebrate?** *Christmas celebrates the birth of Jesus.* 

### Vocab

**Advent**- Advent is marked by the 25 days, or four Sundays, before Christmas. It is defined as a **time of "coming into place, view, or being; arrival"**.

Jesus – the son of God
