Vocab	Christian - people who believe that Jesus Christ is the son of God
	God - the Being worshipped as the creator of the universe
	Creator - responsible for the creation of the world

FACTS	What is family? Family is people that care for you and who are usually related to you. Family is not just the people you live with but can include other people that you are related to.
	How can others be treated with respect? By having regard for the feelings, wishes or rights of others
Vocab	Relationship - the way in which two or more people are connected
	Stereotype - is an idea or belief that people have about a person based on how they look

	What human body parts are there? Any common body part forming the structure of a human body; head, neck, shoulder, arm, elbow, stomach, leg, knee, feet, toes, hands, fingers, heart.
	What body part helps the human body's five senses? Hearing-ears, Sight- eyesSmell- nose Touch-skin Taste- mouth (tongue)
Vocab	Senses - The five senses allow humans to experience the world through smell, taste, sight, hearing, and touch
