# **Science - Plants**

How do plants grow and survive?

#### What do plants need to survive?

Water, sunlight and a suitable temperature (usually warmth)

### What is the lifecycle of a plant?

Germination, roots grow, leaves form, the plant flowers, seeds disperse.

#### **VOCABULARY**

<u>Germination</u> – When the conditions are right, the seed soaks up water and swells, and the tiny new plant bursts out of its shell. This is called germination.

<u>Seed dispersal</u> – Seed dispersal is when the seeds move away from the parent plant. They can be moved by the wind or animals.

Sunlight – All plants need light from the sun to grow well.
