Science – Magnets and Forces		
How do magnets work and what are they used for?		
Facts	A magnet has 2 poles, which are North and South.	
	Opposite poles on a magnet attract and the same poles repel each other.	
Vocab	Magnetism - Is an invisible force that causes objects to attract or repel one another.	
	Non-contact force - To have the ability to move something without touching it.	
	Attract – When materials are pulled towards the magnet.	
Geography- Natural disasters.		
Why do people live near volcanoes?		
Facts	The Earth is made up of 4 layers: Inner Core, Outer Core, Mantle and Crust.	
	Volcanoes are formed when tectonic plates collide and push together.	
Vocab	Tectonic plates - <i>Earth's surface is called the crust. It is made up of different rocky sections called tectonic plates</i>	
	Erupt – When the volcano becomes active and ejects lava, ash and gases.	
	Lava – hot molten or semi-fluid rock erupted from a volcano
